



THE OLD KONGEVEG 14 km one way

The old Kongeveg (royal road) starts at the parking area at Husby and ends at the parking area in Vådal. It is recommended to have a car parked at either end.

This is the oldest thoroughfare in the area, probably stems from the early Iron Age and is part of the old allmannavegen through Innherred. This is certainly one of the roads the peasant army used to travel to Stiklestad in July 1030.

The trail is clearly visible and well marked, it is wet in places but can be walked wearing trainers. There are sheep on pasture, so remember to keep dogs on a leash.

DIRECTIONS HUSBY

Exit E6 at Fleskhus north of Verdal cross over E6 (bridge).

Turn left just after the bridge and keep to the right.

Continue 500 m and turn left onto Husbyvegen. Follow ca 2km to the parking lot to the left.
